Where?

The youth exchange will take place in Setúbal, Portugal.

Participants will be hosted in shared rooms of 3 to 8 persons. We will have a working space approximately 3 minutes away from the accommodation.

When?

Participants should arrive on the 17/02/2022 before 18h00, and leave on 25/02/2023 after 9h00... if possible.

Participants who chose to arrive a few days earlier or leave a few days later are welcome to do so, as long as the extra duration does not exceed 3 days in total and cover their own expenses for these extra days.

The closest airport is Lisbon. The closest train and bus station is Setúbal. Once we know when and where people will be arriving, we will organise pick-up from the airport and/or bus and train stations.

This youth exchange is destined to trans and non-binary persons. Please do not sign up if you are not trans and/or non-binary. All participants must be aged 18 or more.

The pedagogical team is composed of persons with diverse identities and experiences, including trans, non-binary, queer, and cis persons of different backgrounds. The whole team is invested in creating a safer space for the group, however we believe that a space can only be safe if the group is prepared to build it with us.

This youth exchange was designed with and by a group composed mostly of trans and non-binary persons and has the aim to bring together persons from different countries to create empowering narratives and media content together. This media content can include comics, infographics, videos, stop-motion, radio, theatre, music... depending on the group and what we want to do together during the week!

Priority will be given to persons with fewer opportunities to travel and participate in this type of activity.

English will be the main working language, though we will strive to highlight language diversity and will be mindful of those for who English is less comfortable.



No particular skills are required, only curiosity and the wish to participate actively in this week!

How?

The programme covers the costs for travel within a certain budget (see below), as well as accommodation and food, activities and insurance on location.

Each participant is responsible for organising their travel, with the support of their local organisation.

Each participant is also responsible for making sure they have the necessary and valid identification documents, as well as checking any restrictions related to COVID and their individual medical situation. Each participant is responsible for getting tested before they travel and ensuring that they arrive with a negative COVID test.

Each participant is responsible for purchasing their travel tickets and will be reimbursed as promptly as possible after the mobility, on the condition that they provide their invoices and boarding passes, in coordination with their local organisation.

Budget for travel:

France: 250€

Germany: 300€

Spain: 180€

The programme covers three meals a day for all programme days. Please inform your local organisation of any dietary or medical restrictions that should be taken into account by the team.
