USEFUL CONTACTS

ACCIDENTS WITH DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES - WHAT TO DO?

PREVENTION MEASURES

- Know the public information of emergency plans from establishments in your area that involve hazardous materials;
- Organize an evacuation plan with your family, defining a meeting point;
- Have insulating materials available for doors, windows, chimneys, and ventilation systems.

DURING THE ACCIDENT

- React calmly but quickly;
- Stay informed through communication channels and follow instructions from Civil Protection or other emergency services.



IF ADVISED AND IT IS SAFE TO STAY:

- Remain indoors and seal your home from the outside;
- Immediately close the gas safety valve, extinguish any flames, and turn off heating and/or ventilation appliances;
- Seal doors, windows, chimneys, and ventilation systems;
- Move to the most interior room of the house and wait for instructions;
- Cover your mouth with wet cloths if you smell any odour or feel irritation;
- Protect your eyes, and if you experience irritation, rinse them thoroughly with water for several minutes;
- If in a vehicle, close the windows and turn off the ventilation;
- If walking, move quickly and safely away from the wind direction, covering your mouth, nose, and eyes, and minimizing exposed skin.

IN CASE OF EVACUATION

- Leave the area quickly, follow instructions from Civil Protection or other emergency services, and if possible, proceed to the meeting point defined by your family.

The "Seveso III" Directive requires European member states to identify high-risk industrial facilities and take appropriate measures to prevent serious accidents involving hazardous substances. It aims to limit the impact of such accidents on human health and the environment and to ensure high levels of protection.



HIGH-RISK ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALMADA

In the municipality of Almada, within the limits of the parks of Traffic and Caparica, there are 4 high-risk establishments:

- E-02 Enagisa, S.A.
- ETC-Farmilina e Nordeste, S.A.
- Repsol Portuguesa, S.A.

These four are also engaged in the storage and transport of LPG to other "Medium Cost Gas" and "LPG".

SEVESO INDUSTRIES

WHAT IS A MAJOR ACCIDENT?

A major accident is an event which results in a substantial release of a dangerous substance, or significant property loss, resulting from a normal or development occurring during the operation of an establishment which poses a serious, immediate or delayed threat to human health or the environment, and which such measures have been taken.

THE EXTERNAL EMERGENCY PLAN AND SIMULATION EXERCISES

The Seveso III Directive requires that the Member States shall ensure that the knowledge and information contained in the establishments' external emergency plans is widely and easily accessible to the population.
